meeting in June to present the final reports and recommendations for improvement for each participant university as well as the Regional Report. At the same time, the Peers on Education will meet in order to check the progress of the Ignacian Identity and Pedagogy Project in AUSJAL Universities.

Ignacian University Leadership. The 4th Latin American Forum on Ignacian University Leadership will be held in September. It will include the preparation of the new teachers and the last edition assessment. This event reunites teachers and participants of the 4th edition of this program.

Ignacian University Management. The AUSJAL Executive Secretariat will coordinate the 1st Preparatory Meeting that will take place in October, in accordance with the AUSJAL Assembly decision and to meet the need of creating a Formation Program on Ignacian University Management for AUSJAL Universities. The experiences of AUSJAL Universities and other Jesuit networks will be reviewed as a first reference for the program.

Engineering. The Network of Peers on Engineering will hold a meeting to review and promote the network's initiatives. Some of the most outstanding initiatives are: the Course on Environment and Sustainability; the development of an AUSJAL Universities Engineers' Profile; Evaluating the Engineering Faculties Programs through a model based on competences; Launching the Engineering Faculties Web Page.

Network of Peers on Poverty. A meeting will be held in April in order to analyze and compare the national reports of the Component 1 and to check the preliminary reports of the Component 2 of their research. The new Network Coordination run by UIA-Puebla will design the Plan for Reviewing the Contents of the AUSJAL Continental Project on Poverty in Latin America and other future projects and initiatives, in collaboration with the participant universities.

The AUSJAL Digital Newsletter. The AUSJAL Newsletter has been redesigned and transferred to a full digital format since last edition. This new format has the advantages of reaching a greater audience; publishing and promoting a higher number of articles and reflections; and overcoming the difficulties and distribution costs for 30 universities in 14 Latin American

Conference with the General Father. The Agenda of the conference titled «Networking Jesuit Higher Education for the Globalizing World: Shaping the Future for a Humane, Just, Sustainable Globe» which will take place at UIA in Mexico City from April 22 to 24, includes discussing about the following challenges: Theology, science and culture; Market, inequality and poverty; Ecology and sustainability; Regional challenges and networking. AUSJAL Extraordinary Assembly. The AUSJAL President Father Jose Morales Orozco called for an Extraordinary Assembly where participants will evaluate the scenarios for restructuring the Association membership fee and will establish the guidelines for a new AUSJAL Strategic Plan which will be aligned with the Common Apostolic Project of the Latin American Conference of Jesuit Provincials.

Meeting on Legal Clinics and Services. The event called «University and Civil Society for the Defense of Human Rights: The Challenge in Latin America» will be held in the framework of the Meeting for the REDLEIDH Project Board of Directors which will take place in February in Bogota. The purpose of this meeting is to evaluate and conclude the REDLEIDH project. The event will include the participation of Mariela

Saettoni (UCU-Uruguay) and Luz Maria Gil Comerma (UCAB-Venezuela) in representation of AUSJAL Universities. In addition, they will organize a workshop with representatives of the University of York, AUSJAL, ILSA from Colombia, and CELS from Argentina to prepare a strengthening project for legal clinics in Latin America.

University Social Responsibility. This network will meet during the last week of July in order to discuss the self-assessment reports on social responsibility performed by the universities participating in the Institutional Strengthening Project on University Social Responsibility. It is expected to obtain a comparison between these reports as well as strengthening proposals and a regional report on University Social Responsibility in AUSJAL Universities.

Human Rights. The AUSJAL Network on Human Rights, coordinated by Mariela Saettoni from «Universidad Católica del Uruguay», will meet during November 4 and 5 at «Universidad Javeriana» of Bogota. The aim of the meeting is to perform the annual evaluation of the Diplomas on Human Rights offered by the network along with the Inter-American Institute of Human Rights and to present the efforts that have been done in order to obtain the financial aid that will give sustainability to the Diploma through scholarships and other contributions.
